**RE: Open Letter from Faith Leaders In Response To Draft *Anti-Discrimination Bill 2024***

We refer to the “Open Letter from Faith Leaders In Response To Draft *Anti-Discrimination Bill 2024*” dated 1 May sent to you recently.

Our associations represent 75 Christian schools with over 47,000 students enrolled in our schools across Queensland. As Christian school leaders, we have raised similar concerns as those outlined in the Faith Leaders letter and requested meetings to discuss our concerns with the Attorney-General and Education Minister, without success.

We are now seeking the opportunity to raise these concerns directly with you as Premier.

We **endorse the concerns expressed by the Faith Leaders** about the proposed *Anti-Discrimination Bill 2024* which would significantly impact our schools and their communities. We join with the Faith Leaders in **urging you and the State government to consult further with faith community leadership** before putting this Bill to Parliament.
